5.1 Conclusion

The writer discusses about the politeness strategies that used in Movie *Maleficent: Mistress of Evil*. The writer choose this movie because the movie has seen by a large number of children, the politeness strategies used in this movie does not have a vulgar sense. The writer can assume that the politeness strategies in this movie script is to show that something belongs to a specific group, express disappointment, express that argue show or express awkwardness and embracement, reduce the seriousness of the conversation, convince someone in a conversation, show that one belongs to a specific group, express enjoyment, or make the hearer comfort. This study was interesting and has moral value. This study has answered the research question that stated in the earliest chapter and it can be the aspects of politeness strategies in movie *Maleficent: Mistress of Evil* are Bald-on record, Off Record, Positive Politeness, and Negative Politeness. The description of politeness strategies in movie *Maleficent: Mistress of Evil* are Bald-on Record occurs 70 times (30.8%), Off Record occurs 31 times (13.7%), Positive Politeness occurs about 89 times (39.2%), and Negative Politeness occurs 37 times (16.3%). The most dominant of

politeness strategies in movie *Maleficent: Mistress of Evil* is Positive Politeness occurs 89 times (39.2%). This is relevant to what has been stated in learning pragmatics especially in politeness strategies.

5.2 Suggestion
