1.1. Background of The Study

Language is the system of human communication which consists of the structured arrangement of sounds or their written representation and come into larger units, such as morphemes, words, sentences, and utterances. In common usage it can also refers to non-human system of communication for example the “language” of bees, the “language” of dolphins, etc. Some languages are spoken by only part of the population of a country, for example Tamil in India, French in Canada etc. Besides, languages are usually not spoken in exactly the same way from one part of a country to the other. The differences in the way a language is spoken by different people are described in terms of regional and social variation (Richards and Schmidt, 2010: 311).

In writing foreign language, in this scope is English, an advanced skills are needed. Some students sometimes find difficulties in writing, so this will cause them get a low score in the writing skill. There are several factors that might influenced the low level of the students’ score; such as the lack of mastering English Grammar, the low ability in listening, speaking, reading, and writing including the lack of mastering vocabularies. Even tough, vocabularies are one of the elements of learning English, students often feel difficult to understand and keep the vocabularies in mind.

Al-khresheh (2016: 49) explained in this case that Students have difficulties in practicing it learners and second language teachers have always

done the errors for very practical reasons. The teachers should be able to not only identify the errors, but also understand the linguistic reasons for their errors.

To know the causes of errors, Novita (2014: 2) had a state that there are two factors which cause the students commit error. They are interlingual and intralingual factors. In this research, the writer analyze the tense, word order punctuation, articles, nouns, pronoun, verb, prepositions, adjectives of the students' writing. Usually some students know about the generic structure of descriptive text well but in the reality, they do the wrong writing like in their grammatical.

Based on Wignell (1994: 208), the function of descriptive text is to describe a particular person, place or thing. From first characteristics of descriptive text, which is used to tell right now, it means that descriptive text use simple present.

While the aim of the writing is to express the idea of the writer to the readers, there will be some ideas that must be seen as the most important aspect of the writing. Besides, the writer needs to pay some attention to formal aspects, such as neat handwriting; correct spelling; punctuation; as well as acceptable grammar and careful selection of vocabularies.
