CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Study

Language is a means of communication among human being. Bull (2008:247) language is a system of communication in speech and writing by people of a particular country. The use by humans of a system of sound and word to communicate. According Hartmann and Stork (1972:123) .language is the most fundamental means of human communication. Language has often defined as a system of arbitrary symbols used in interpersonal communication by aggregation of human beings and which are rather exhaustively catalogue thing, process, and event in human environment. Based on the definition, language is also used in the written form to convey the feeling thought of ideas.

The main purpose of using language is to communicate meaning or message by combining such means of communication, namely, gestured, signs, or drum beating. According to Bull (2008: 84) communication is activity of expressing ideas and feeling or of giving people information. In communication a person has a certain purpose. These interpersonal meaning are realized in the lexicogrammatical through selections from the system of MOOD.
