CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

In this chapter, the writer would like to draw conclusions and suggestion after analyzing the data in the chapter IV. The writer would like to write some conclusions and he would like to propose his suggestions.

5.1 Conclusion

- 5.1.1 The interpersonal meaning in the script movie "Smurfs: The Lost Village" are identified from the wording of clauses based on the elements of interpersonal meaning consist as Mood and Residue such as Subject, Finite, Predicator, Complement and Adjunct. The mood maintained such as giving or demanding goods and services or information. While residue refers part of the clauses which is not belong to the Mood.
- 5.1.2 Based on the analysis of the script movie, the dominant mood in the script movie "Smurfs: The Lost Village" is declarative mood. There are 367 declarative mood (79%), 65 interrogative mood (14%), and 44 imperative mood (9%).

After knowing the result of the research of analyzing clauses in the script movie "Smurfs: The Lost Village", the writer would like to propose he

suggestions that are useful to the readers, scholars, lectures, new researchers, and English Department in developing of English.

The suggestions are:

5.1.3 For the readers
