CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of Study

The era of globalization, people cannot live alone. The people need help from the others. The people need to have communication as a human social, and language is one of the most common communication tools. English is a communication tool and English is a language that we can find anywhere. Writing skill is specific abilities which help writers put their thoughts into words in a meaningful form and mentally interact with the message. Writing skill helps the learner to gain independence, comprehensibility, fluency, and creativity in writing.

Writing has become an important thing nowadays. Writing is part of language learning. Some teachers tried to stimulus students to write, especially in English. The teachers also tried some techniques improve students' writing skill. Based on interview with English teacher, the researcher found the problem that student tend to be difficult to write something in English. The students also tend to be difficult to determine the content and they feel afraid if their grammar is wrong.

In the Senior High School, students learn about the some text. One of them is Narrative text. Based on curriculum 2013, Narrative text is one of text that should be mastered by students at eleventh grade. Narrative text it is story with complication or problematic events and it tries to find the resolutions to solve the problem (Munand, 2014). Narrative text is considered as the most interesting text. Narrative text is a form of story text that has purpose to entertain readers (Larasati, 2016). In writing narrative text, the students sometimes have some difficulties to write because of some factors such as the idea and the imagination of students' still poor and the limitation of time also influence the students to write. There are some techniques in teaching writing; one of the techniques is Round Table.

Round table technique is one of the cooperative learning techniques that can be used for increasing students' writing skill. Roundtable is a technique that can be used for brainstorming. In roundtable, the student is designed to generate a large number of ideas about a topic in a group with the other students. It can be an excellent teambuilding technique ensures that all member of a group are involved (Sepianita, 2010).

According to Kagan (2009), round table technique is learning technique where the students take turn in their team by generating their responses, solving problems, or making a contribution to a project. The students can do the writing task with their friends for their team. They also can express their ideas easily to make the supporting sentences in paragraph. And in this research, the researcher used Round Table Techniques to improve students' writing in narrative text.

1.2 Problem Identification

The Problems in this study can be caused by students and teacher. First, the students still have low writing skills. They also still find it difficult to express their ideas in written form. They tend to feel less confident in writing.

They still feel afraid of mistyping, such as the structure of grammar or to determine the appropriate vocabulary.

The second, teacher is not motivating students to improve their writing.

Teacher usually rarely use the media or methods of teaching, so students to lack enthusiasm to learn during the study.
